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# DIRECTORY OF CARE HOMES IN WEST LOTHIAN

## INTRODUCTION

In May 2005 the Office of Fair Trading published a report called Care Homes for Older People in the UK: A Market Study, which gave detailed information about how Care Homes delivered their services and the process for seeking a placement in a Care Home. The report also included a series of recommendations for future action. One of these recommendations was that good quality information about local Care Home provision should be made available to the public to enable anyone considering a move into a Care Home to make an informed choice of placement.

In response to this recommendation, West Lothian CHCP, in partnership with local providers of Care Home services, has produced this Directory of all Care Homes in West Lothian. The Directory includes information on all the key aspects of a Care Home service and is detailed in the same way for each Care Home to enable anyone considering a move into a Care Home to easily begin to compare the services available.

However, the Directory is intended only as a starting point in the process of choosing a Care Home placement and as a guide to many of the areas that anyone planning a move may wish to consider in more detail.

### **Considering a move into a Care Home**

For anyone who is considering a move into a Care Home, initial information about the range of local Care Homes can help to answer some questions and act as a reminder of other questions they may wish to ask.

Further, more detailed information is available from a range of sources:

- The Scottish Commission for the Regulation of Care (the Care Commission) is the independent public body responsible for ensuring that every Care Home meets the requirements detailed in the National Care Standards for Care Homes for Older People. The Care Commission carries out regular inspections of every Care Home to measure their performance against these standards and publishes an Inspection Report, including any recommendations, requirements or enforceable actions they have imposed, after each visit. Each Care Home is required to make their Inspection Reports readily available and anyone considering a move into a Care Home should ask to see a copy when visiting the unit.

### **Planning a move into a Care Home**

Social Work staff can provide information and advice about moving into a Care Home and can offer support throughout the process of doing so. Importantly, anyone living in Scotland and planning a move into a Care Home, and who has been assessed by the Local Authority as requiring the level of care provided by a Care Home, is entitled to financial assistance towards the cost of Care Home fees and this is accessed via local Social Work Departments.

## **Paying for a Care Home placement**

Information on the cost of each Care Home is detailed under each entry in the Directory. There are two different weekly Care Home rates listed:

### **1. Local Authority funded**

This is the weekly rate charged to anyone moving into a Care Home who, after a means-tested financial assessment by the Local Authority via their Social Worker, has been deemed eligible for additional funding over and above the free personal and nursing care allowances. People who are eligible for a Local Authority funded placement will contribute their weekly income, minus a personal spending allowance, towards the cost of their placement but will not have sufficient capital or assets, such as property, to contribute more. In these circumstances the Local Authority will pay the difference up to a maximum weekly amount which is reviewed each financial year.

### **2. Free Personal and Nursing Care (self-funded)**

This is the weekly rate charged to anyone, currently living in Scotland, moving into a Care Home who has capital or assets, such as property, with a value greater than the annually set maximum amount allowed in order to be eligible for additional Local Authority funding. In these circumstances, the Local Authority will only pay the standard non-means-tested free personal or nursing care weekly amount towards the weekly Care Home charge. The free personal care weekly amount is currently £145 per week and the free personal and nursing care weekly amount is currently £210. The balance of the Care Home weekly fee is met by the resident.

The Care Home weekly fee for free personal and nursing care (self-funded) residents is set by the Care Home and this is why some Care Homes have two different weekly rates - one for Local Authority funded residents and one for free personal and nursing care (self-funded) residents.

Individual circumstances can vary a great deal and the Directory can provide only basic information and guidance. It is important that anyone considering a move into a Care Home should discuss their eligibility for financial assistance with a Social Worker in greater detail to ensure that they receive all their relevant entitlements.

## **Other things to do when considering a move into a Care Home**

It is a good idea to go and visit any Care Homes you may be considering moving into. Even if you have a clear preference for a particular Care Home it is still helpful to visit at least one other Home in order to be able to compare different services or to confirm your choice.

If you are not able to visit the Care Home yourself, ask someone to do so on your behalf, perhaps a family member or friend or carer. Advise them beforehand of any particular things you want to know about the Home so that they can be sure to find these out for you. If you don't have anyone to visit the Care Home on your behalf, a Social Worker will be able to talk to you about the Care Homes in West Lothian.

When planning to visit a Care Home, telephone in advance to arrange a time to visit when the Manager or a member of staff will be available to show you round and to spend time with you answering any questions you may have. Care Homes are happy to welcome people who want to find out about their service.

It is helpful to prepare a list of questions or things you want to find out about the Care Home beforehand as it is easy to forget things at the time of the visit.

As well as viewing the communal facilities when visiting the Care Home, ask if it is possible to see what the bedrooms and en-suite facilities are like. This will allow you to begin to think about how many of your personal possessions you may be able to take with you.

Finally, talk to as many people as you want to about your move and ask as many questions as you like.

It is hoped that this Directory will help you to begin the process of considering what you need to know in order to plan a successful move into a Care Home at a time that is right for you.
